

## **ROUTES TO LOCHSIDE LODGES**

**Warning!!!! If you use GPS to navigate here our post code will only take you to Barcaldine. The entrance to Lochside Lodges is off the A828 beside a small white boat with Creran Marine on the side on the Loch Creran side / North side of the road.**

### **From the South**

You will be traveling on the A85 towards Oban.

At Connel go under the bridge, past The Ferryman's/Oyster Inn on the left hand side then turn sharp left to go over the Connel Bridge onto the A828 to Fort William.

Barcaldine is now only 8 miles North.

Drive through the village of Benderloch (last minute shopping at the "Famous Pink Shop" on the right hand side) then one mile past the Scottish Sea Life Sanctuary you will see a small white boat marked Creran Marine on the left hand side of the road. Turn in and take the left hand fork down the lane.

Turn left and you have arrived.

### **From the North**

At the Ballachulish Bridge take the A828 to Oban.

The A828 meanders for several miles down Loch Linnhe until you pass the Creagan Inn on your right. Cross the Creagan Bridge over Loch Creran. Very shortly there is a Forestry sign for Sutherlands Grove on your left then come out of the woodland and the road is wider and straight.

Now keep an eye out on your right for a small white painted boat with Creran Marine written on the side.

Turn in and take the left hand fork down the lane.

Turn left and you have arrived.
